#### Europeiska ERV Alarm - in case of emergency

In case of serious accident or illness, always call both the local emergency number as well as our alarm central Europeiska ERV Alarm, open 24/7/365. They have a world wide network of physicians, healthcare professionals, psychologists, priests, etc. They can for instance issue payment guarantees\* and contact your relatives.

#### Euro-Center - for information and service

Our service offices, Euro-Centers, are located all around the world and can help you on the spot with information, advice and claims. The personnel speak both the local language and Scandinavian. They know the culture and cooperate with hospitals and agencies. Euro-Center can also issue payment guarantees\* if necessary. Always keep your insurance card, with the insurance number, with you at all times during travel. If something happens and you need to contact either the alarm central or Euro-Center you will be asked to state your insurance number.

If something happens during your business trip, you can make your claim 24/7 at [erv.se](http://erv.se) to get compensation.
